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Title: Citizens Advisory Committees

Adopted: 9/27/62 Revised: 3/2/70

The School Board may from time to time enlist the aid of qualified residents of the district by the creation of advisory committees for the study or development of specific projects and formulation of recommendations for Board consideration.

Members of committees shall be appointed by the Board, with staff advice, and the right to dissolve such committees is reserved to the Board.

The Board shall weigh carefully advice contained in interim or final reports of such committees, but shall exercise its own judgment in arriving at decisions and determining courses of action.

Nothing in this policy statement shall preclude administrative or supervisory personnel or teachers from initiating and developing means for obtaining advisory assistance in school program and plant operation from qualified individuals or groups, either resident or non-resident.
