USE OF FACILITIES FOR DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS</p> <p>The Board establishes that groups within the community may distribute student-related notices through the schools, provided that such distribution does not interfere with the educational program of the schools.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee will develop procedures for the granting of permission and for distribution of notices of meetings, programs, events or activities through the schools.</p> <p>This policy maintains the authority of professional employees to distribute educational or student services materials (e.g., in-school tutoring, classroom book purchases, class rings, yearbooks, etc.) to students or staff with principal approval.</p> <p>Approval for requests to distribute materials related to fundraising by Group 2 organizations are governed by Policy 1230.</p> <p><u>Categories Of Groups</u></p> <p>The Board may permit distribution of student-related notices to students/parents/guardians by organizations that fit within any of the following categories:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Group 1 School-sponsored student activities including official clubs and groups, as well as intramural and interscholastic sports teams of the district.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Group 2 School-related and Board-approved organizational support groups, including, but not limited to, parent-teacher organizations, booster clubs, alumni association, teachers' federation, etc.</p>
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Group 3 Any of the following groups located within the boundaries of the Peters Township School District: youth-related sports organizations, sports camps, or recreational groups (e.g., the Recreational Department); nonprofit educational groups (e.g., Public Library); or nonprofit community, civic and service groups that serve the Peters Township School District (e.g., Scouts, service clubs, civic groups, fire/police departments, etc.).

Required Disclaimer

All notices approved for Group 2 organizations shall display the following disclaimer in bold capital letters on a cover sheet or at the top of the flyer.

For Cooperative Events –

THIS GROUP IS WORKING IN COOPERATION WITH THE PETERS TOWNSHIP SCHOOL DISTRICT TO OFFER THIS EVENT OR PROGRAM.

For Independent Events –

THIS GROUP IS SHARING THE ATTACHED INFORMATION THROUGH THE PETERS TOWNSHIP SCHOOL DISTRICT. THE EVENT OR PROGRAM IS NOT INITIATED OR SUPERVISED BY THE DISTRICT.

All notices approved for Group 3 organizations shall display the following disclaimer in bold capital letters on a cover sheet or at the top of the flyer.

THIS EVENT, PROGRAM OR GROUP IS OPERATING INDEPENDENTLY OF THE PETERS TOWNSHIP SCHOOL DISTRICT. DISTRIBUTION OF THIS INFORMATION DOES NOT INDICATE ENDORSEMENT BY THE DISTRICT.

Right To Refuse

The Superintendent or designee reserves the right to reject notices for Groups 1, 2 and 3 submitted for distribution or display by any individual or organization at any time. The privilege to use the district distribution system and its display areas is meant to serve residents of the district as a community service.
