

Policy: 1340

Title: Access to School Procedures, Materials, and Facilities

Adopted: 3/2/70 Revised: 2/19/73

No use of school buildings or district procedures, materials, or facilities not related directly to the School district's program of instruction or extra-curricular activities shall be permitted except as provided in School Board policies or, where no specific policy covers the exigencies of the situation, by authorization of the Superintendent. This prohibition shall be construed to include use of buildings, public address systems, bulletin boards, internal mail distribution facilities, duplicating equipment, paper, etc.

This policy shall not operate to prevent continuation of normal cooperative relationships with Parent-Teacher Associations, nor shall it prevent use of schoolrooms for private or group instruction after school hours by PTA sponsored instructors or by school personnel. Such instruction by school personnel shall be restricted to hours after the employee's daily obligation to the district has ended and to teaching which involves no ethical conflict on the part of the employee, and shall be subject to the approval of the Superintendent.

Where the provisions of this policy and the terms of any agreement or contract in force between any duly certified employee union or association and the School district are in conflict, the latter shall prevail. However, this policy shall not provide expanded or greater benefits than provided in any agreement or contract in force for covered employees, nor shall this policy be employed to change, modify, or expand provisions included in applicable agreements or contracts.
