COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Fourth Grade English Language Arts Curriculum will focus on five areas that are directly related to the Pennsylvania Core Standards. Students will read and respond to works of literature and informational text, with emphasis on comprehension, making connections among ideas and between texts with a focus on textual evidence. Students will write for different purposes and audiences, focusing specifically on conveying a well defined perspective and appropriate content. More specifically, the students will write Narratives, Opinion, Informational, and Text Dependent pieces. Through this they will demonstrate a grade appropriate command of the English language in regard to grammar and mechanics.
