FIRST GRADE

For each of the sections that follow, students may be required to understand, apply, analyze, evaluate or create the particular concepts being taught.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Language Arts in first grade focuses on developing

foundational skills of phonemic awareness, phonics, spelling, vocabulary, fluency, grammar, and comprehension; developing skills to effectively communicate information, oral and written, with many audiences.

• Develop the foundational skills of literacy in the areas of phonemic awareness, phonics, word recognition, and fluency

- Balance informational and literary texts
- Build content knowledge and academic vocabulary
- Provide texts with appropriate and increasing complexity, teaching how to access complex text
- Use text-dependent questions so reading and writing are grounded in the text
- Provide phonics, phonemic awareness, grammar, and spelling instruction to support literacy
- Use Close Reading as a strategy to dig deep into a text and to reread for different purposes

• Provide opportunities for shared, interactive, and independent writing to model and use strategies and skills for the integration of reading and writing to sources.

• Provide opportunities for collaborative conversations so students learn from each other, collaborate, and support their answers with text evidence.

STUDY SKILLS

Vocabulary: Theme related, Oral vocabulary and High-frequency words, Strategies for Multiple Meaning Words, Shades of meaning/Intensity, Prefixes, Suffixes, Inflectional Endings.

Reading comprehension strategies: Visualize, Ask and Answer questions, Make and confirm predictions, Reread, Main topic and Key details.

Reading comprehension skills: Character, Setting, Events, Main Topic and Idea, Key details, Plot, Text Connections, Compare and Contrast, Sequence, Point of view, Cause and Effect, Problem and Solution.

Genre: Realistic fiction, Fantasy, Informational text/Nonfiction, Play, Folktale, Biography.

Fluency: Phrasing and Intonation, Expression, Skills of Dialog.

Phonological Awareness: Rhyme, Alliteration, Phoneme isolation, Phoneme blending, Phoneme segmentation, Phoneme categorization, Phoneme identity, Phoneme substitution, Phoneme addition, Phoneme categorization, Phoneme deletion, Phoneme Reversal and Contrast vowel sounds, Syllable Addition and Deletion.

Phonics/Spelling: Short vowels, Long Vowels, Blends, Diagraphs, Irregular Vowel Patterns, Variant vowels, Silent Letters, Three letter Blends.

Structural Analysis: Inflectional endings, Double final consonants, Plural nouns, Alphabetical order, Possessives, Contractions, Open/Closed syllables, Prefixes, Compound Words, Irregular Plurals, Abbreviations, Final Stable Syllables.

Writing skills: Write to sources

Trait: Ideas and Organization, Word Choice, Sentence Fluency, Voice.

Grammar skills: Sentences, Word order, Statements, Questions, Exclamations, Writing sentences, Nouns, Adjectives, Verbs, Adverbs, Prepositions, Pronouns.

Mechanics: Capitalization and Punctuation, Question and Exclamation Marks, Commas in a series, Commas in dates and letters, Contractions, Apostrophes, Underlining, Abbreviations.
