COURSE DESCRIPTION

Fifth grade students will study 6 units related to the AP Themes: 1) Families and Communities 2) Science and Technology 3) Beauty and Aesthetics 4) Global Challenges 5) Contemporary Life and 6) Personal and Public Identities. In addition, students will briefly learn about some cultural aspects of Spanish-speaking countries, including holidays. This is a yearlong course based on a maximum of 48 classes.

Furthermore, students are motivated to use the target language and to make connections between their second language and concepts taught in content areas.
