<b>Science</b>	<p><b>(7<sup>th</sup> grade)</b> 1" 3-ring binder, note cards, paper supply, pack of 5 dividers, extra- large book cover &amp; basic calculator.</p> <p><b>(8<sup>th</sup> grade)</b> 1.5" 3-ring binder (white), note cards, basic calculator, paper supply, pack of 5 dividers and an extra- large book cover</p>
<b>Social Studies</b>	1.5" 3-ring binder with paper supply
<b>Language Arts</b>	2" 3-ring binder with paper supply, pack of 8 tabbed dividers, red pen, highlighter, 1 pack of 3x5 index cards
<b>Mathematics</b>	<p><b>(7<sup>th</sup> grade)</b>- 1.5" binder with paper supply, several pencils, extra-large book cover, calculator: TI-30XS multi view</p> <p><b>(8<sup>th</sup> grade)</b>- Several pencils, spiral notebook, folder, several red pens or pencils. One extra-large book cover.</p> <p>Calculator TI-30XS multi-view <b>(Strongly recommended – supported in the classroom)</b></p>
<b>World Language</b>	<p><b>Spanish-</b> 2" 3-ring binder, paper supply, pack of 5 dividers, 1 pack of 3x5 index cards, highlighter</p> <p><b>French-</b> 1.5" 3-ring binder, paper supply, pack of 5 dividers</p> <p><b>German-</b> 1.5" 3-ring binder, 5 dividers, 100 sheets of loose leaf paper</p>
<b>Reading 7</b>	1" red binder with inner pockets, 3 hole binder pencil pouch (large enough to hold a novel)
