FOOD SERVICE - Lisa Runco

*Changes to menus being required – 50% of all grains must be whole grain then 100% by 2013–2014 school year. Will require students to take fruits and vegetables. New law requires taking a fruit and a vegetable. Might be able to collect uneaten fruits and vegetables for compost bin. There will be a price increase for lunches (15 cent increase for paid meals, which was approved).
