Course Overview and Essential Skills

Seventh Grade Comprehensive Music is provided to students everyday for twelve weeks. The program is aimed at a variety of musical experiences. The program is also aimed at developing general music abilities through piano and vocal performance and creative music abilities. The class builds on elementary music experiences in learning to read and write music as well as listen to a variety of musical forms and styles. Some of the class goals are: to develop a musical literacy, explore and develop skills using electronic multi-timbral, programmable keyboard instruments and explore and develop skills using computer music software.
