Unit or Topic	Course Activities/Resources	Timeframe
Human Development	In this unit, students will examine the typical stages of human development while emphasizing the major tasks mastered at each stage of the human life cycle. Resources: Human Development outline, Glencoe online module (object permanence)	One Week
Families	In this unit, students review the types of families, identify the importance of healthy families, and analyze family member roles. Resources: Families study guide	One Week

Decision-making	This unit will review the decision-making process. Students will also work through common teen decision-making scenarios. Resources: Decision-making study guide, Glencoe Health online module (teen brain)	One Week
Junior Achievement	Through the use of Junior Achievement community volunteers, the unit will introduce students to various concepts related to future careers: personal brand, career clusters, in demand careers, career mapping, job search strategies, skills for obtaining and keeping a job. Financial Literacy	This unit will use the Financial Literacy 101 program to introduce concepts related to financial literacy – budgeting, credit, financial planning, banking, and check writing. Resources: www.smartfutures.org	One Week
My Career Journey	This unit will use the My Career Journey program to explore various careers which match individual students' skills, interests, values, and personality characteristics.
