This sheet is intended to give you an overview of curriculum, assessment and classroom rules. Mission: That every child will experience and learn the elements of music through singing, moving, reading, discussing and playing musical instruments.

Units of Study for Grade One:

Beat – Feel, tap, move and play instruments to a steady beat **Rhythm -** Decode, speak and perform:

Tempo – Fast, moderate and slow

Meter – Notation for the barline, double barline, repeat sign, meter sign, and music in two's and three's **Pitch** - Sol, Mi, La

Melody - Upward, downward, and repeated melodies

Harmony – Accompaniment and no accompaniment

Expressive Elements – Loud and soft; *p* and *f* symbols

Form – Same and different, AB and ABA patterns

Musical Styles - Songs performed in several styles

Tone Color – environmental sound effects, contrasting sounds of the adult and child voice

Music Literature - Peter and the Wolf by S. Prokofiev

Vocal Techniques – Speaking, singing, whisper and calling voices

Instrumental Techniques - Playing of rhythm percussion with songs and stories; care and playing technique of Orff instruments, basic bordun

Assessment:
