Mission: That every child will experience and learn the elements of music through singing, moving, reading, discussing and playing musical instruments.

Units of Study for Grade Two:

Beat – Feel, tap, move and play instruments to a steady beat **Rhvthm -** Decode, speak and perform:

Tempo – Fast, moderate and slow

Meter – Notation for the barline, double barline, repeat sign, meter sign and music in two's and three's **Pitch** - Sol, Mi, La, Do, Re,

 $\label{eq:melody-upward} \textbf{Melody} - \textbf{Upward}, \textbf{downward} \text{ and repeated melodies}, \textbf{melodic improvisation of pitch patterns}$

Harmony – Student performed accompaniment

Expressive Elements - p and f symbols; crescendo and decrescendo

Form - AB and ABA patterns; verse and refrain

Musical Styles - Stylistic differences in contrasting pieces

Tone Color – Environmental sound effects; tone color of stringed instruments

Music Literature – *The Nutcracker* by P. Tchaikovsky

Vocal Techniques - Proper posture for singing, singing in the "head voice," phrasing

Instrumental Techniques - Playing of rhythm percussion and Orff instruments with songs and stories, basic bordun, broken bordun, and pentatonic improvisations

Assessment:

- 1 Student's work consistently exceeds expectations
- 2 Student's work consistently meets expectations
- 3 Student's work needs improvement
