Mission: That every child will experience and learn the elements of music through singing, moving, reading, discussing and playing musical instruments.

Units of Study for Grade Three:

Beat - Play rhythm and melody instruments to a steady beat; move to a steady beat through dance and free movements

Rhythm - Decode, speak and perform:

Tempo - Largo, moderato, and allegro

Meter - Music in two, three, and four; meter signature

Pitch - Sol, Mi, La, Do, Re, Do'

Melody - Melodic movements by steps and leaps

Harmony - Canons (rounds)

Expressive Elements - mp and mf symbols; use of changing dynamics as one means of expressing mood in music

Form - AB and ABA, verse and refrain, rondo form

Musical Styles - Songs of the American, Native American, and African American culture

Tone Color - Tone color of string, brass, woodwind, and percussion instruments

Vocal Techniques - Proper posture for singing, singing in the "head voice," tone production, and vowel sound production

Instrumental Techniques - Playing of rhythm percussion and Orff instruments, basic bordun, broken bordun, moving bordun, and pentatonic improvisations, introduction to recorders, BAG
