The flute is the highest pitched woodwind instrument, and has a light, feathery tone. Listen to Sir James Galway and Jeanne Baxtresser.



Oboe

The oboe plays mostly high pitches with a unique tone produced by the double reed. Listen to Heinz Holliger and Ariana Ghez.



Clarinet

The clarinet plays a wide range of pitches with a full, round tone. Listen to Richard Stoltzman and Sabine Meyer.

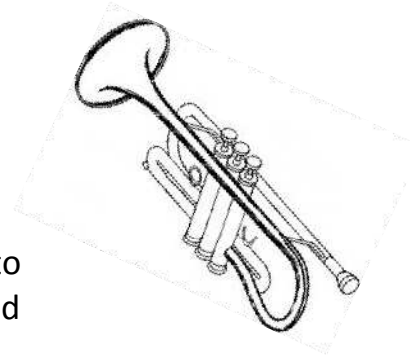


Saxophone

The saxophone plays middle range pitches with a bright brassy sound. Listen to John Coltrane and Charlie Parker.

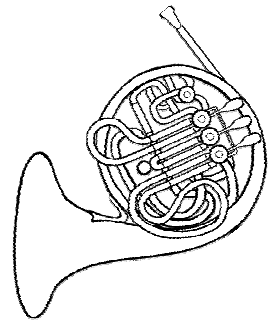
Trumpet
