

Kindergarten Eligibility

Children must be five years old on or before September 1, 2014 to enter kindergarten.

If your child will not be five years old by September 1, 2014, and you wish to explore early entry, please contact the building principal to review early entry criteria.

Please register your child at the school he/she will be attending in the fall on the dates listed below.

Official Documents Needed for Registration

You must bring your child's birth certificate, registration of birth, or baptismal certificate (if the date of birth is included on the certificate).

If your child's name is different than the one on the birth certificate, you must bring legal documentation providing the legality of the present last name. Adoption papers and court orders are acceptable: a letter from an attorney is not.

You must bring your child's immunization records. Regulations of the Pennsylvania State Department of Health require that children be immunized prior to admission to school for the first time.

The requirements are:

- ✓ 4 doses of tetanus (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- ✓ 4 doses of diptheria (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- ✓ 3 doses of polio
- ✓ 2 doses of measles
- ✓ 2 doses of mumps
- ✓ 2 doses of rubella (German measles)
- ☑ 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella(chickenpox) vaccine or history of disease

If there is a medical or religious reason why immunizations are not complete, please contact your school nurse.

You should bring any information concerning your child's health history. This information should include all childhood diseases and operations. (Bring along your baby book.)

- District policy also requires that you bring 3 items as proof of residency. They may include:
 - ✓ Mortgage or lease agreements (temporary proof only)
 - ✓ Driver's license
 - ✓ Auto registration
 - ✓ Utility bills
 - ✓ Tax statements
 - ✓ Check stubs from wages, public assistance, or social security Additional information on proof of residency can be found in District policy 5118.1 on the District website.

Kindergarten Information Online

In early March kindergarten information will be available on the Peters Township School District's website at www.ptsd.k12.pa.us.

The ABC's of Kindergarten web pages include information about our program and a virtual tour of Bower Hill and Pleasant Valley Schools. You can share this tour with your child. Dental and Physical Exams

Your child is required to have a dental and physical exam upon entering school. These exams may be done by your child's private physician and dentist. Appropriate forms will be available at registration.
