Crew Assignment for Live Production	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will be assigned a role on the academic production team that produces a live television show.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Daily participation
Video Projects	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Topics will be assigned and chosen.• Depending on the project, you may work in a group or alone- maximum three students per group.• When working in a self-chosen group on a self-chosen project, members will be individually graded-you will act as a story boarder, a camera person, and as an editor.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Length of project assignment will be from three days to three weeks depending on the specific project.• Number of projects will vary each nine weeks.
Equipment and Skill Proficiencies	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hands-on skill tests will be performed by students.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• As needed each nine weeks.
Event Shoots	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You are required to sign up for each event shoot.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Two event shoots each nine weeks.
