

Many of these goals and objectives fall within the realm of academic performance and achievement. Still others are born out of our Core Values and dedication to Steven Covey's 7 Habits of Highly Effective People. These goals and objectives, viewed through a lens of leadership and character, are how we feel we will be best able to provide your children what they need to realize their utmost potential and become the leaders of tomorrow.

One of the many areas of focus for Character Counts at McMurray Elementary for the 2010-2011 school year will be manners. With all of the new means of communication that we have available to us and the preferred modes of communication of today's youth, we feel as though it is important to reinforce these social pleasantries and mores of the community.

During the onset of Character Counts week, November  $15^{th}$ - $19^{th}$ , classes will discuss manners and determine what they feel the top five manners for the school should be. We will encourage children to be specific, such as saying "Please" and "Thank you" verses "being nice". Each homeroom teacher will identify his/her class' top five manners, and we will compile these lists to determine which will be McMurray's *Top 5 Manners*. Bookmarks with these manners will be made for each student. We will also have students performing skits on the

morning announcements that exhibit and model the use of these manners.

In addition, each classroom teacher will choose at least 1 student to be their class' "Secret Manners Monitor". These students will be given "Kindness slips" for him/her to report when they see someone being kind, using good manners, et cetera. A McMurray Manners box will be outside of the guidance suite for the mystery monitors to place these slips. Administrators, teachers, monitors, support staff, and parents are all encouraged to report acts of manners and kindness. Extra kindness slips will be available. These slips will be read and transferred onto stars to be displayed outside the multipurpose room.

It is our sincere hope that by reinforcing the polite behaviors that you have instilled in your children that we may help our students to enhance our school climate and culture as well as enable them to adjust and navigate the many situations and environments they will find themselves in throughout their lives.

## **New Safety Initiative for PTSD**

Beginning September 13, 2010, all visitors to Peters Township School District will be required to show photo identification at any of our schools (driver's license, state issued photo ID, etc.) when entering.

This additional level of security allows us to better track visitors to the buildings and to help to validate the parents and community members who are entering the buildings. Visitors will provide their ID cards to the main office staff and be given a visitor's pass for their visit.

Upon return to the main office to sign out from the visit, the visitor's ID will be returned to them. Visitors who are dropping off items in the main office and not entering the main building will not be required to provide photo ID.

For large group events at McMurray Elementry School, parents can access an admission pass through their child's Power School page. Safety is a partnership between our staff

members, students, parents and the community.

The District will continue to proactively work to improve the level of security throughout our schools to protect the students of all ages who are entrusted to the care of the school district throughout the day.
