

Peters Township Middle School PTA Meeting - Minutes

April 13, 2012

I. Welcome/Pledge of Allegiance

- a. President Gina Wells called the meeting to order at 9:21 a.m. There were approximately 19 people in attendance. (see attachment)
- b. The Pledge of Allegiance immediately followed.

II. President's Remarks- Gina Wells

- a. Gina welcomed the 6th grade parents in attendance.
- b. Gina thanked all who contributed to the free-will donation that purchased 3 books to commemorate Evelyn Jozefkowicz's 90th birthday. Each has a name plate in her honor and the books were donated to the PTMS library.
- c. On Monday, April 16th, the Peters Township Police Department will be previewing a drug and alcohol prevention program for parents. The program preview will take place in the Community Room at the Police Department at 10:30 a.m.
- d. Kennywood tickets will be on sale in all buildings throughout the district on Monday April 30th, specifically at the Middle School from 11:15 a.m. to 1:15p.m.
- e. The rules for the Reflections contest for the 2012/2013 school year have been streamlined to make the submission requirements more "user-friendly".

III. Principal's Report- Dr. Freado

- a. Dr. Freado also welcomed the parents of 6th graders for attending.
- b. A decision has been made by the PT School Board that the accelerated middle school students will continue to attend the high school for early morning classes.
- c. On April 26th, Peters Township High School will operate on a 2 ½ hour delay schedule as the high school staff participates in safety training. PTMS students who normally report to the High School will report directly to the Middle School on that day only.
- d. The "Artist-In-Residence" Program will have a ceremonial unveiling of the framed glass etchings for those students who participated in the program. The artwork will be mounted in the windows at the Middle School.
- e. A PTSD Administration Building restroom has been modified and made accessible for spectators at the Middle School athletic field area.
- f. Teachers, counselors, and administrators from McMurray and the Middle School continue to work together to plan for a smooth 6th grade transition. The last day of school is a "step-up" day for 6th graders and PTMS students act as ambassadors to help answer questions from current 6th graders.

- g. Student planning books will require a payment beginning next year. A future e-mail blast will outline the details for the ordering and payment process.
- h. The Peters Township Character Counts is sponsoring a free concert performed by the United States Air Force Night Flight Jazz Ensemble. The concert will take place at the PTHS Auditorium on April 28th at 7:00 p.m. Donations will be accepted at the event for Operation Troop Appreciation to benefit our deployed troops.
- i. Mr. Henaghan, Assistant Principal, announced the PSSA testing schedule: April 18-19, Grade 8, Writing; April 25th, Grade 8, Science.
- j. Dr. Freado is working with teachers and students on the development of a touchstone for display as a visual reminder of what our students stand for and strive to become.
- k. The 8th Grade Dance will take place on Saturday, June 2nd and an appropriate dress code will be strictly enforced.
- l. Dr. Freado addressed questions from assembled parents.
