PRINCIPAL'S REPORT – LORI PAVLIK

- Thank you for supplying College Planning Night guests with dinner. It was well attended.
- PSAT scores being mailed home. We are encouraging 11th grade students to log on and see their scores on College Board. The resources are helpful on College Board. Kids did well overall. They did as well as in the past. No changes which says the new SAT is not going to be harder which is good. Academic and honors classes prep for March SAT.
- College Board has done a nice job of putting together teacher resources and showing how to incorporate the skills kids need for the classroom and about how they're being tested.
- Juniors should be taking new SAT. Colleges won't take old SAT.
- College Readiness test on English side and Math side will be in October. College Readiness benchmark now given with new PSAT. Score determines readiness for college. Helps see what instruction is needed. We are looking at juniors and sophomores but getting juniors reading first. Analysis being done for all grades. Focus is to see how they can do even better. Elementary grades doing work to improve as well.
- Friday night basketball game was standing room only.
- Senior Sebastian Yocca was accepted into the U.S. Naval Academy. Congressman Tim Murphy recognized Sebastian with a special certificate during the February 5th boy's varsity basketball game at PTHS.
- Dance Team performed and made 2nd place.
- Mrs. Ragland gave report on PTHS's first NMSI Saturday session. Pizzas and gift cards were given out to some students. NMSI supplied lunch. Presenters had nice things to say about the students.
- Google calendar for teachers to use to not overlap exams.
- Snowball dance is Saturday. Sponsored and chaperoned by cheerleading boosters. It's a fundraiser for cheerleaders. Not a school function.
- Glow Dance is February 26th. Sponsored by the National Honor Society. It's an informal dance and is school sponsored. Proceeds go to Make A Wish Foundation.
- Scheduling: Education Committee will talk about new courses and tweets to course selections.
- Keystones: Governor did sign into law change to exam. They are still required by the state for graduation. If students don't pass the exam, then they take the Keystone course.
