Step 1:

Visit <http://junior.scholastic.com>


PC: Internet Explorer or Firefox

Mac: Safari or Firefox



Step 2:

Click the blue button labeled “Log In,” which will lead you to a new prompt.



Step 3:

Click on the “I am a Student” button to access the Student Log-In screen.

Step 4:


Type our class password **PT1718** into the box. Click the blue button “Sign In” to access issues.

Step 5:

Your teacher will provide the article’s TITLE, ISSUE DATE, and PAGE NUMBERS at the time it is assigned.

Note: If you choose to wait until its due date, you may need to scroll down to view recent issues.

You can visit old articles by clicking on “All Issues” in the blue bar at the top.




Step 6:

Make sure the correct issue is loaded by making sure the ISSUE DATE is the same as the one your teacher assigned.


Click on the article that is assigned.

This will send you to the article's text.



Step 7:

You may choose to read the article from this page by scrolling down.



If you prefer, you may "Open Magazine View," which is like looking through a magazine. It has zoom and highlighting tools. (Seen below)
