Important Information

- 1. When: September 23, 2023 Where: Peters Township High School
- 2. Tickets will be sold ONLINE ONLY this year at pthomecoming23.eventbrite.com
- 3. Students must turn in a signed homecoming waiver form to validate any ticket purchase. An email will be sent with the link for ticket sales with more information.
- 4. All outside guests must complete a signed outside guest form and the accompanying waiver form.
- 5. This is a formal event and formal attire is required at all times.
- 6. No refunds will be given if a student violates this agreement and its subsequent rules.

Requirements and Expectations during Peters Township High School Homecoming

- 1. Students must arrive at the Homecoming dance between 6:30 and 7:00 p.m. No students will be admitted after 7:30 p.m.
- 2. Students will be permitted to leave the dance at any time, but under **no circumstances** will readmittance to the dance be granted. Otherwise, the dance will end at 10:00 p.m.
- 3. Students attending the dance will be monitored by school staff and Peters Township police to ensure student safety.
- 4. Drugs, alcohol, weapons, tobacco and any other illegal and/or dangerous contraband are not permitted. Portable breathalyzers will be on site and may be used. Students suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol or in possession of a weapon will be subject to the applicable policies and procedures of the high school and school district which includes school discipline, Peters Township Police charges, and restriction from participation in other school activities. By signing this permission form, you are also giving consent for a breathalyzer test to be given with reasonable suspicion.
- 5. All backpacks, bags, and purses will be searched prior to entry. All students will be required to empty their pockets prior to entry.
- 6. Students are not permitted to bring food, drinks, other liquids, and/or prescription/non-prescription medications. (Students requiring medication of any kind must make arrangements with an administrator.)
- 7. Inappropriate, sexually explicit dancing, including grinding, is prohibited. Students who engage in inappropriate dancing will be immediately removed from the dance and sent home. No warnings will be given.
- 9. Students who violate any of the above rules/expectations or other rules contained in the Student/Parent Handbook may face disciplinary consequences and removal from the dance. Current PTHS students may face suspension and/or social probation.

I understand and agree to the conditions of purchasing tickets and attending the PTHS Homecoming Dance. I will abide by the above expectations for behavior, and I understand the consequences for failure to comply.
