## \#1 Lockers

$\square$ Your child will be assigned a locker

- All lockers have a combination lock
$\square$ Lockers can be accessed between classes
- It is your child's responsibility to keep his/her locker organized and clean
$\square$ Book bags must stay in lockers
- He/She cannot carry a book bag to and from classes

We suggest...
$\square$ Buy a combination lock and have them practice over the summer
$\square$ Remind them that...
$\square$ The first week of school will be the most challenging - it will get easier!
$\square$ The Guidance Office has all the combinations written down (if they forget!)

## \#2 Getting Lost \& Being Late

$\square$ The First Day Schedule is Adjusted

- Allows additional time for students to get organized
- Teachers will be in the halls to help students find their way

Students typically adjust quickly to changing classes

- Time management is key!
- As long as they are direct and efficient, they will not struggle to get to classes on time.
$\square$ If late, have a pass from a staff member

We suggest...
$\square$ Having your student attend the $6^{\text {th }}$ Grade Orientation held in August to walk their schedule and practice their locker combo
$\square$ Remind them that staff members will be there to help

$\square$ Will your child have homework? YES!

- It is typical to have homework almost every night (especially in math)
$\square$ Don't let it pile up!
$\square$ Online Homework - Canvas Parent App
$\square$ Grades reported in PowerSchool
