Peters Township School Closure Extended

This evening, Governor Tom Wolf has ordered the closure of all non-life-sustaining businesses effective at 8 p.m. tonight in an effort to slow the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus.

With this new development and the updated recommendations from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the **Peters Township School District will now be closed through Friday, April 10, 2020.** We are hopeful that these measures, along with aggressive social distancing, will help stop the spread of COVID- 19.

Initial interpretation of the Governor's orders will allow for the distribution of the Grab & Go meals for our families to continue. Pick up will take place as planned tomorrow at the High School from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. In the event that further clarification of the orders require that we discontinue the Grab & Go service, we will communicate that immediately to our families.

Please continue to follow the recommendations established by the [CDC](#) to protect you and your family during the COVID-19 outbreak. The safety of our staff, students and community is our highest priority.
