

# PETERS TOWNSHIP SCHOOL DISTRICT: PLANNING FOR THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR

## Parent Survey Summary

Thank you to our families who took part in our June 2020 survey to help inform our planning process for the 2020-2021 school year. For your reference, an overview of the data is summarized below. As we work to create a safe learning environment for our return to school in the fall, your continued input in this process is important.

### Who Responded?

- 2,015 Families representing 3,789 students
- 95% of our enrollment represented

### Technology

- More than 97% of families reported reliable home internet service
- 94% believe their internet to be fast enough to support District devices for students
- 96% of parents felt somewhat or very comfortable with technology use

### Mask Usage

- 64% felt that face masks should be optional for staff (if not required by the PDE)
- 69% felt that face masks should be optional for students (if not required by the PDE)

**Note:** At the time of the survey masks were recommended, but as of July 1 masks became mandatory in the school setting with limited exemptions.

- Bower Hill - 46%
- Pleasant Valley - 55%
- McMurray - 50%
- Middle School - 46%
- High School - 57%

Note: Some grade totals may not equal 100% due to rounding.

- As expected, the traditional education model was preferred by most families.
- Families who chose remote learning options were split equally at 50% who preferred asynchronous instruction and 50% who selected synchronous.
