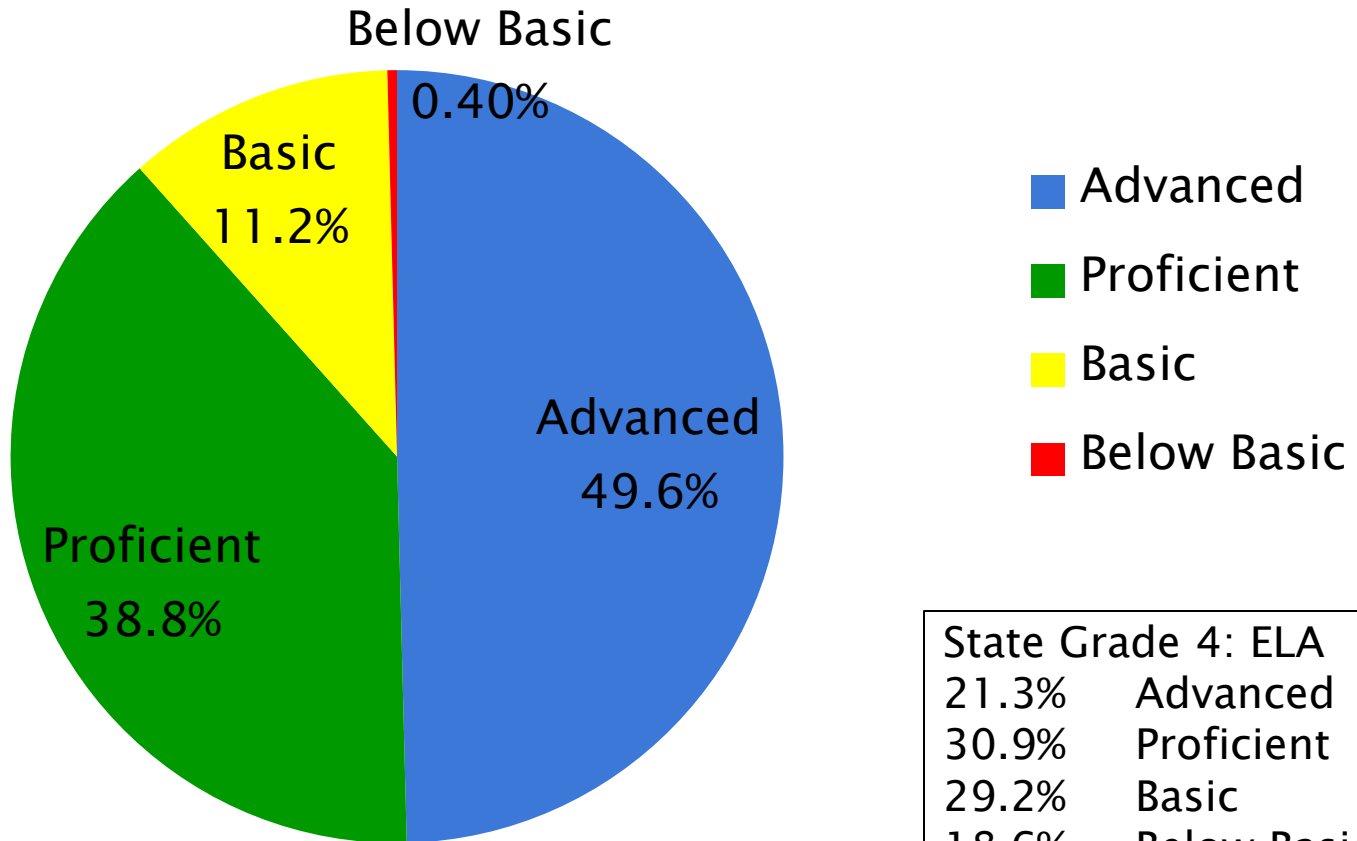

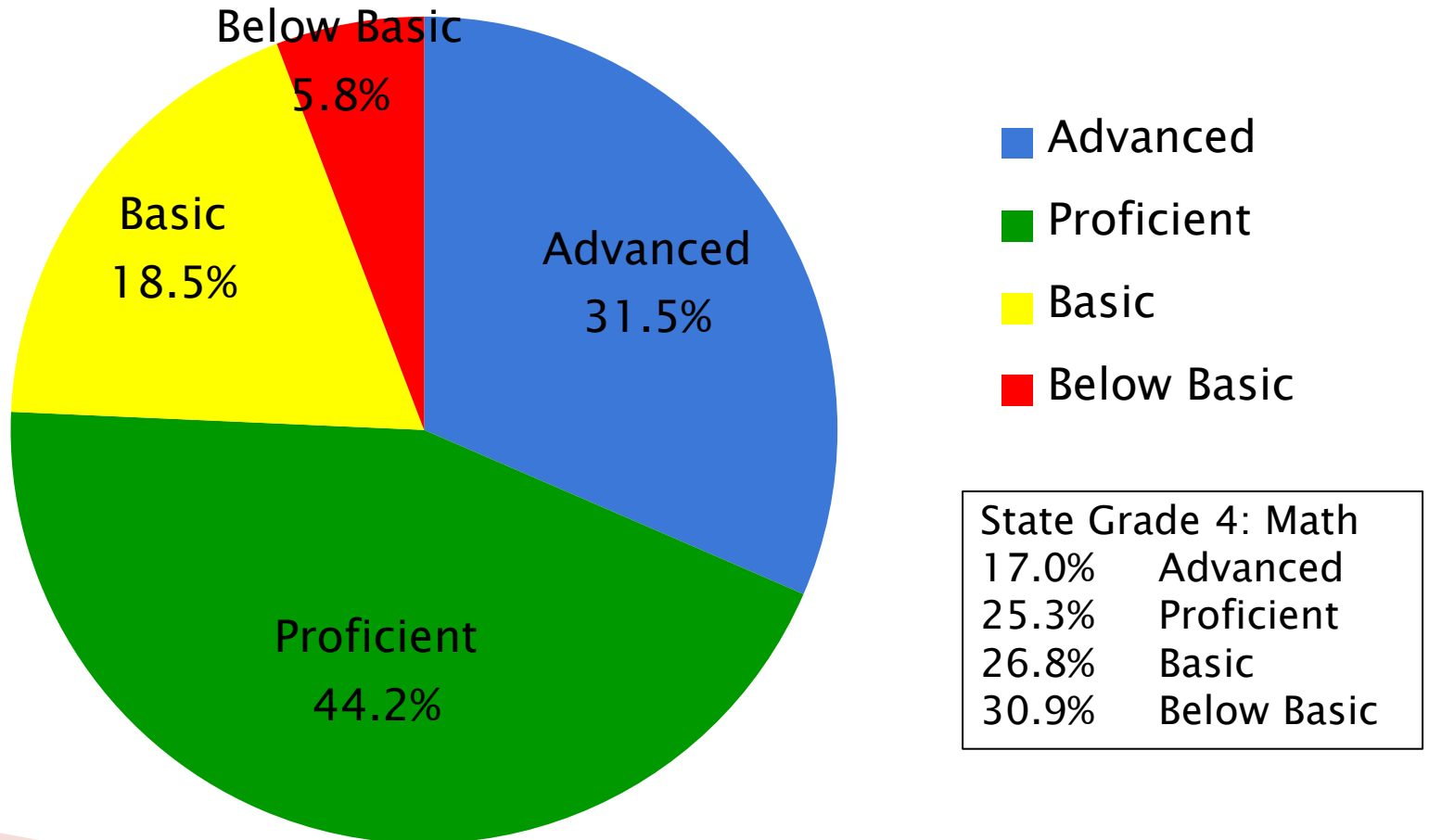

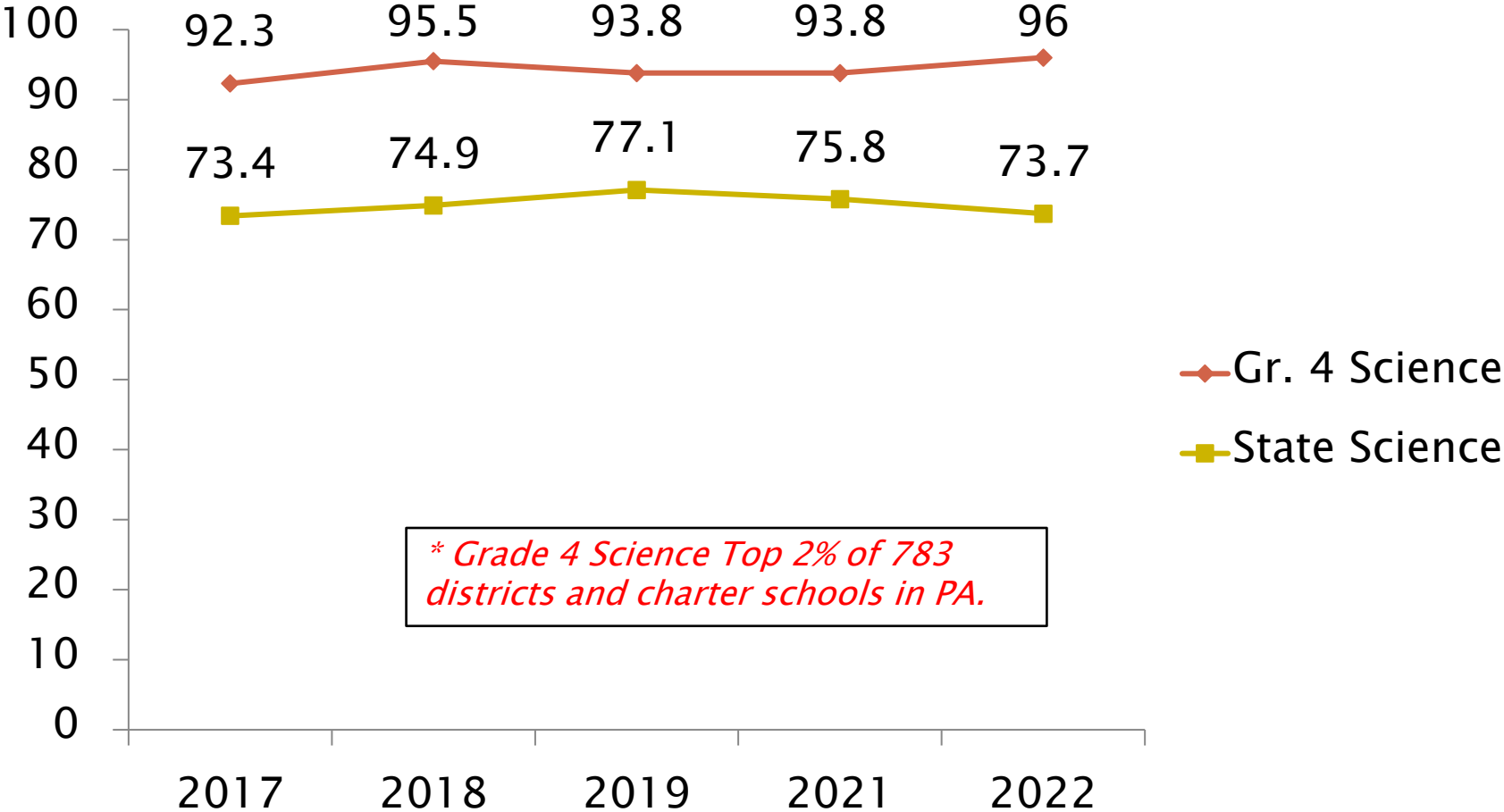

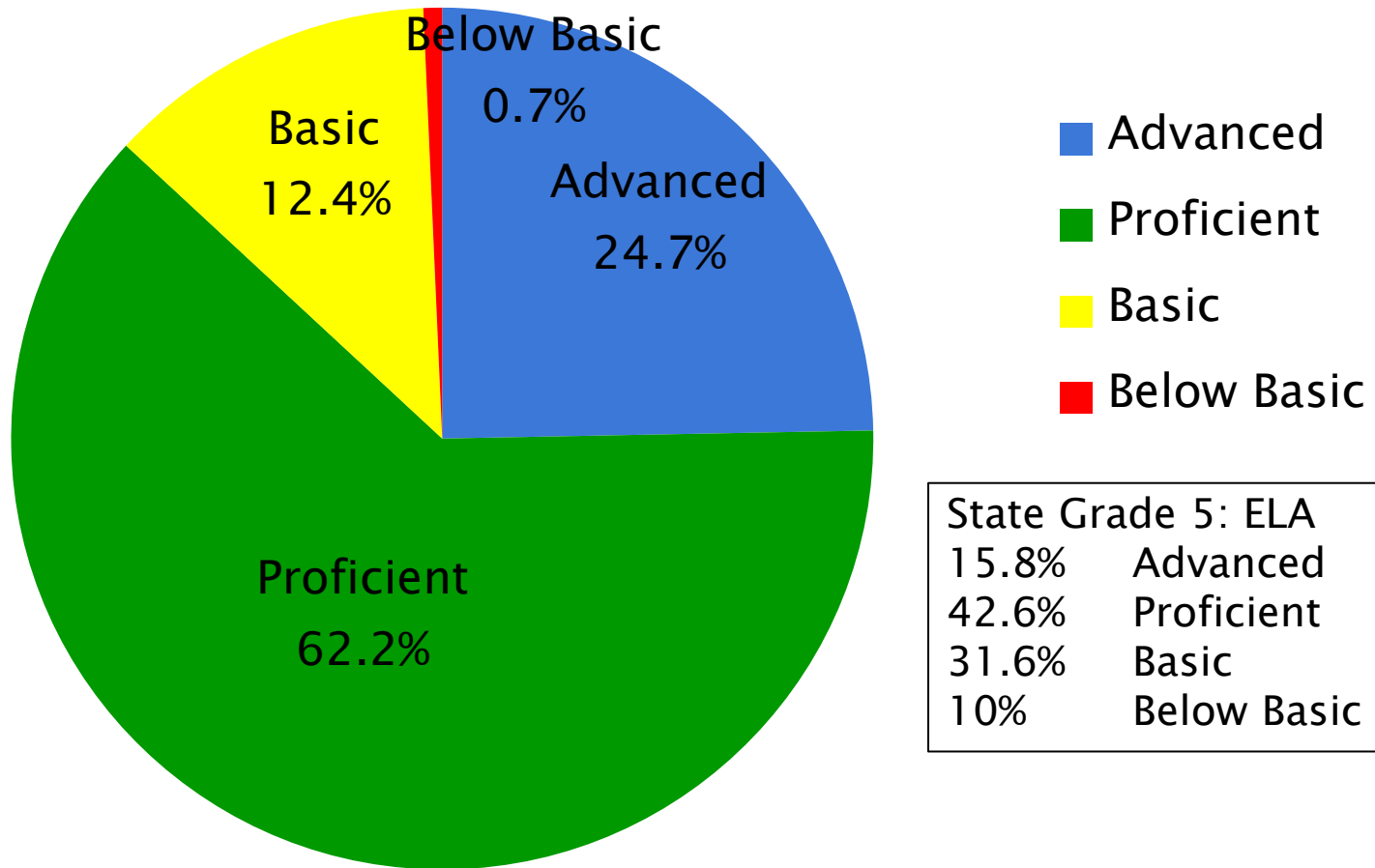

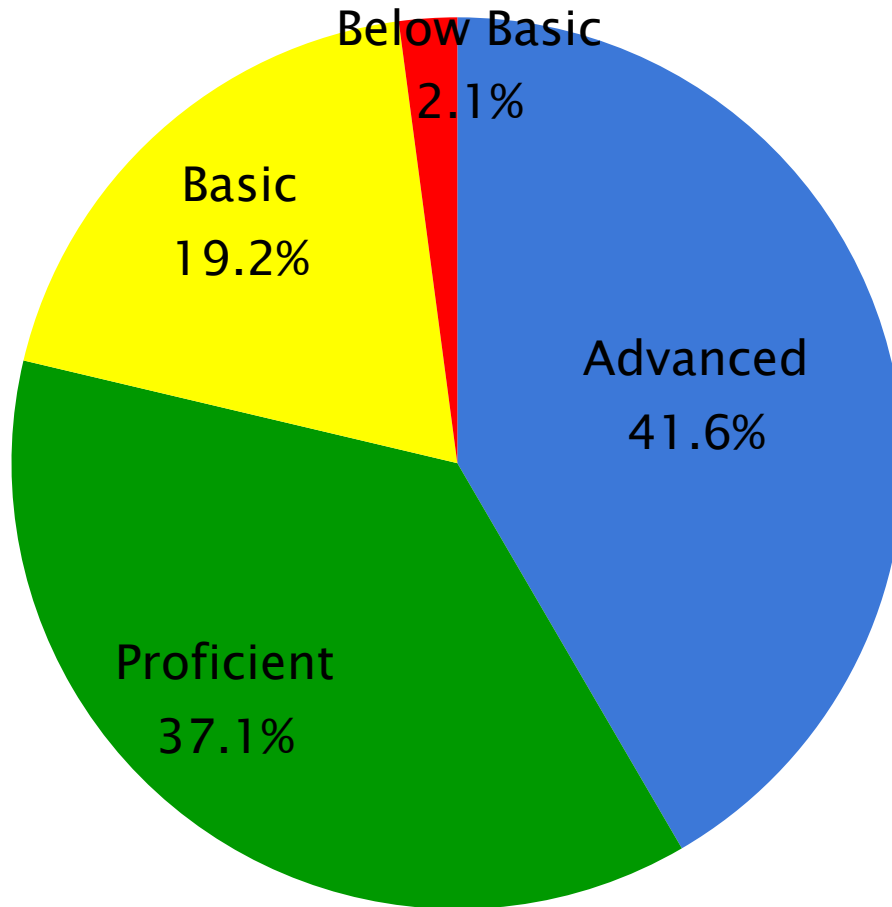

What is Growth Data (PVAAS)?

Pennsylvania Value-Added Assessment System

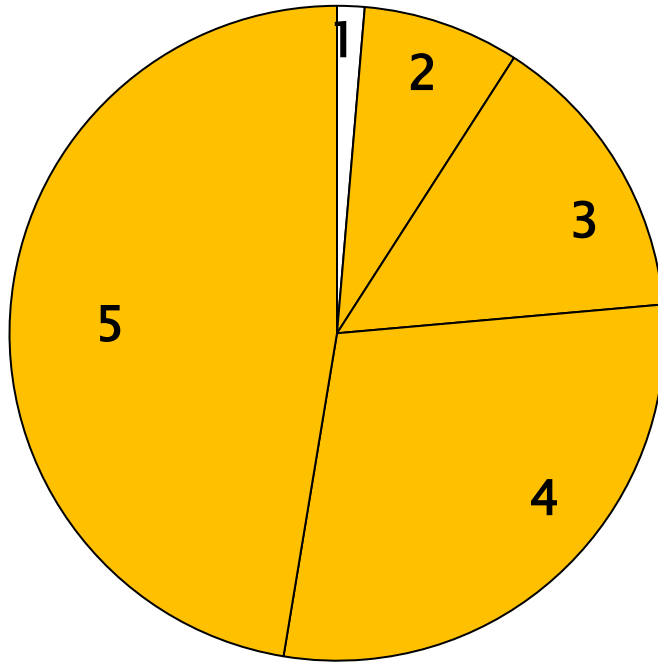
- ▶ PVAAS measures a group of students' growth across time, i.e., across years.
- ▶ Compares student performance to his/her own past performance.
- ▶ Measures student achievement as a result of the influence of educational practices, classroom curricula, instructional methods, and professional development.

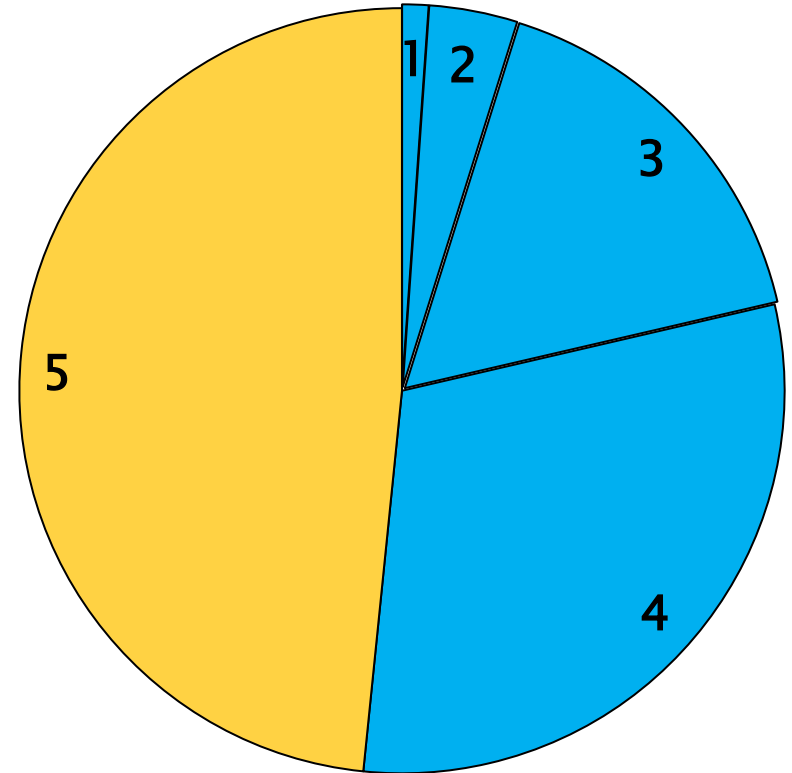

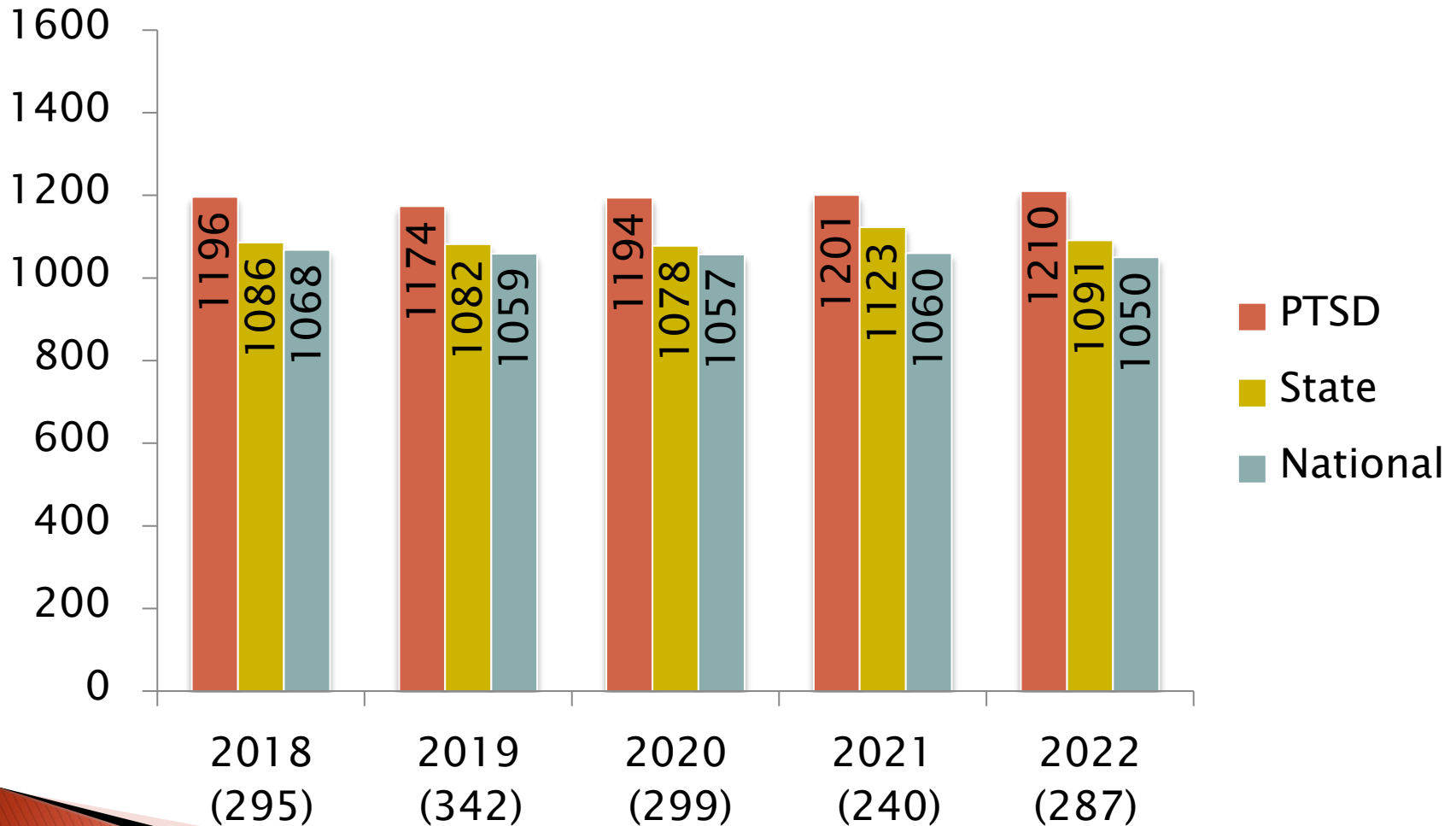

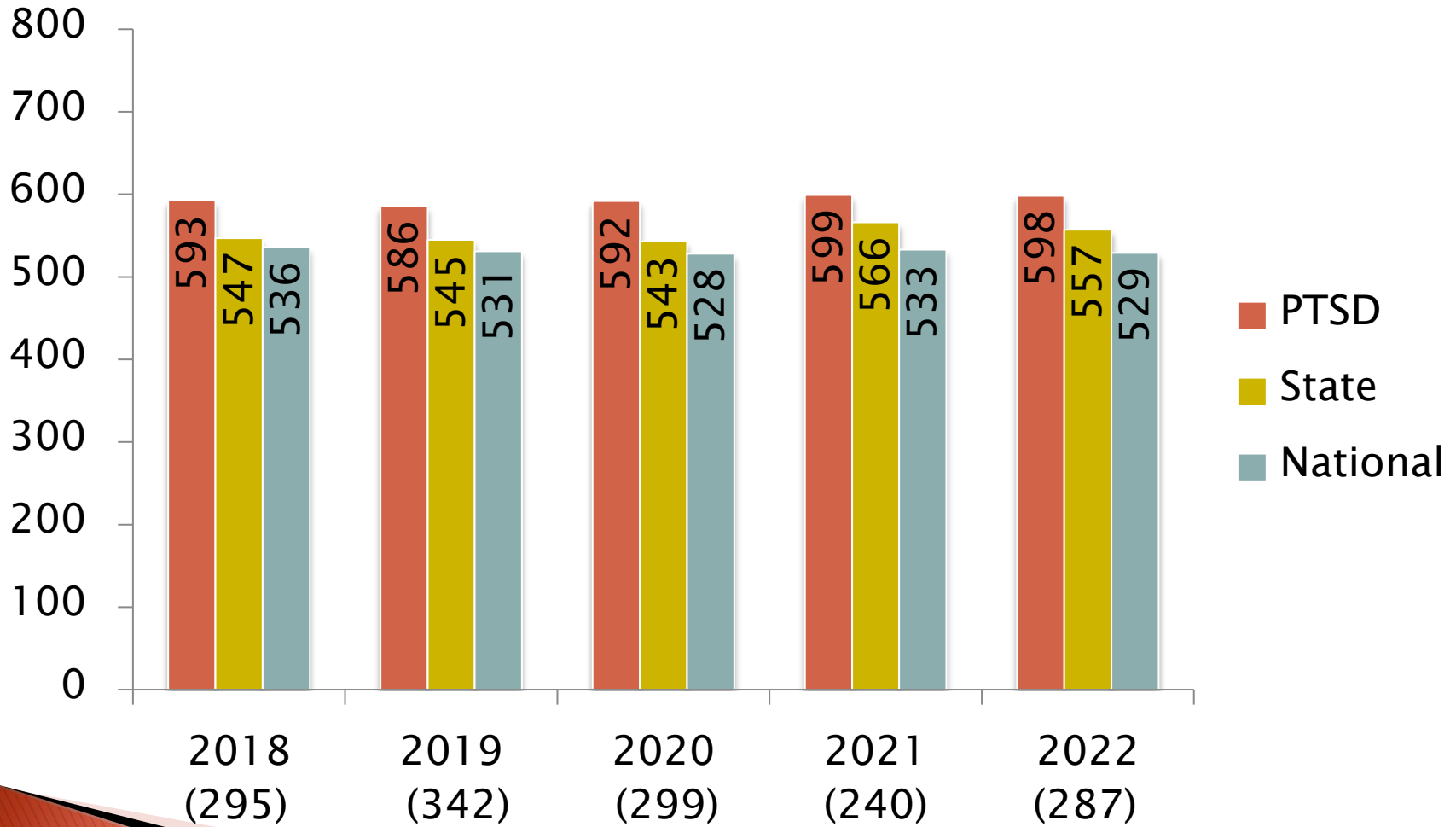

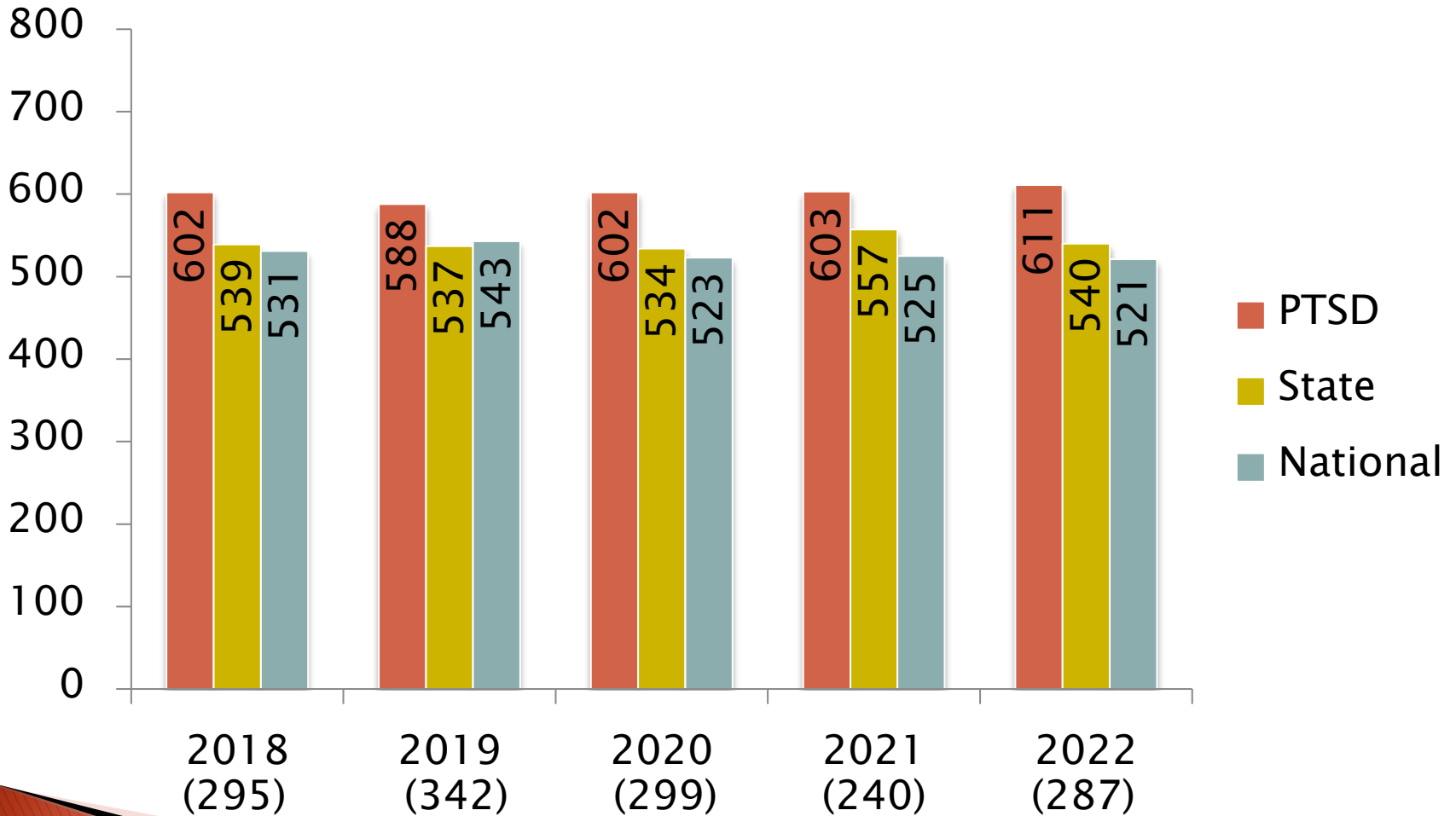
SAT Total Score Five Year Trend (2018–2022)



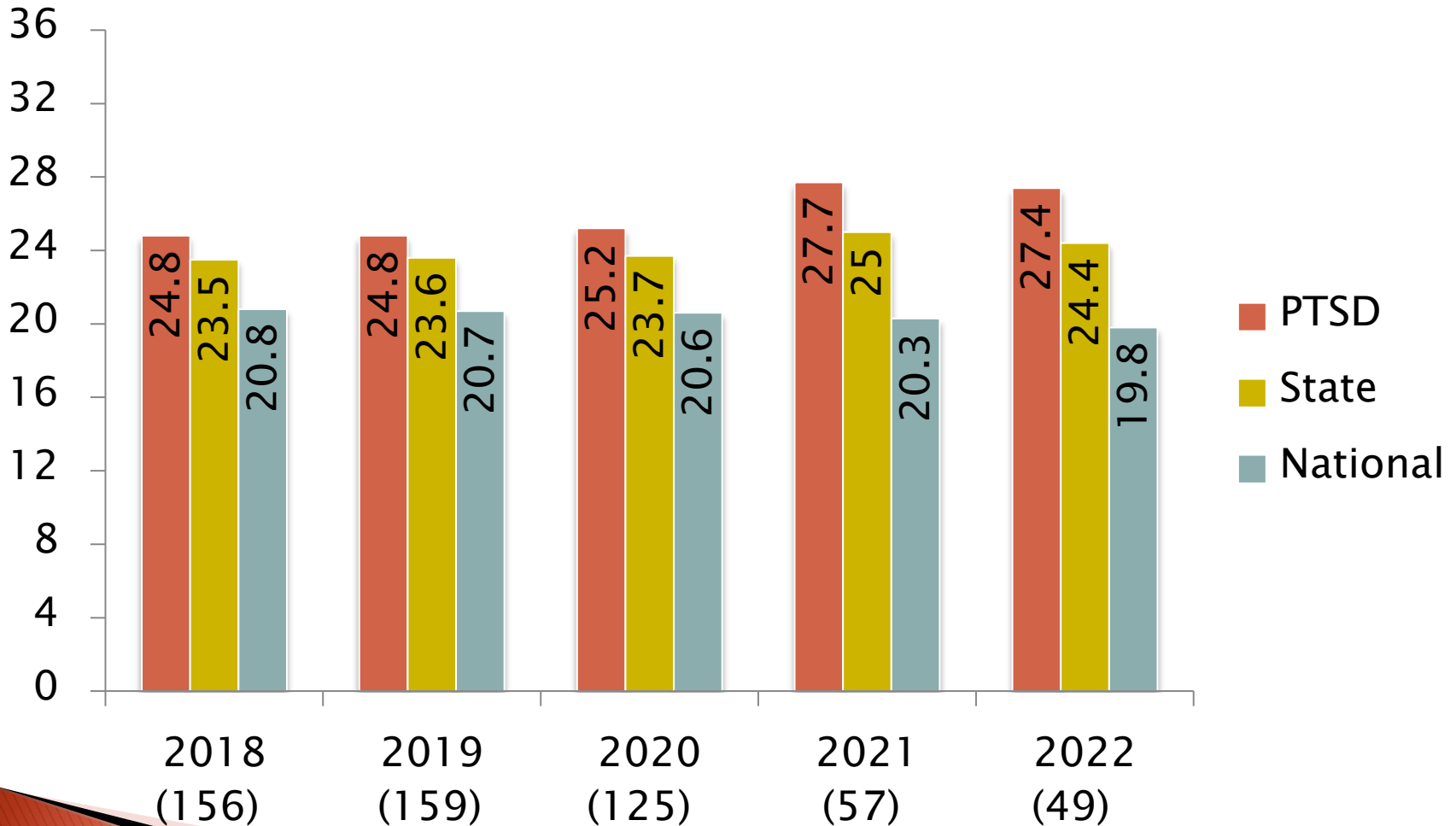
SAT ERW Score Five Year Trend (2018–2022)



SAT Math Score Five Year Trend (2018–2022)



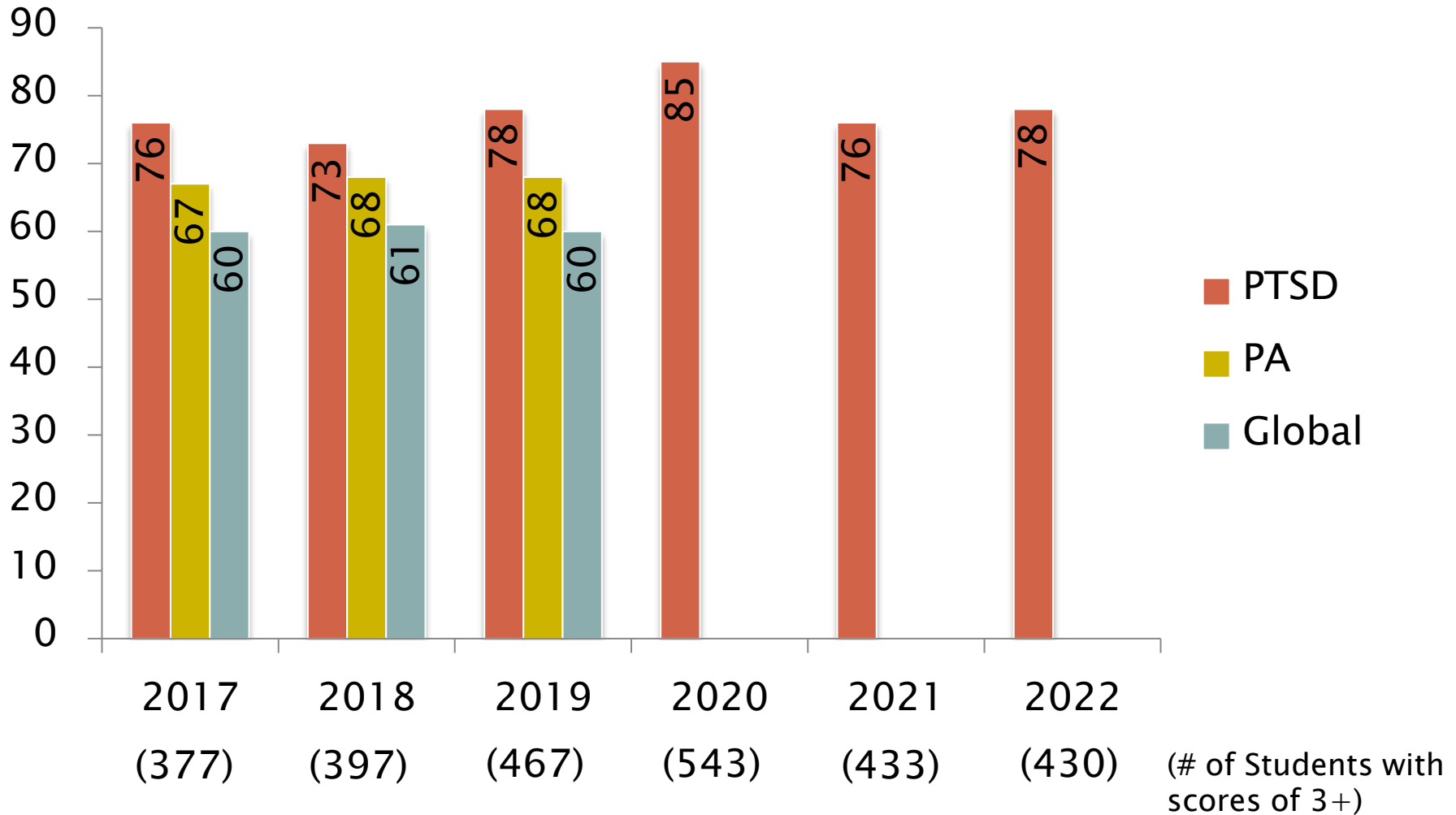
Composite ACT Scores Five Year Trend (2018–2022)



Advanced Placement (AP) Exams

- ▶ 78.1% of PTHS test takers scored a 3 or higher.
- ▶ In 2022, 550 students took 1,211 AP Exams with 430 students scoring a 3 or higher. In 2021, 569 students took 1376 AP Exams with 434 students scoring a 3 or higher.
- ▶ In 2022, 89 students earned AP Scholar with Distinction Awards by earning at least an average score of 3.5 on all AP Exams taken and scores of 3 or higher on at least five or more exams. In 2021, 92 students earned AP Scholar with Distinction Awards.
- ▶ In 2022, 45 students earned AP Scholar with Honors Awards by earning at least an average score of 3.25 on all AP Exams taken and scores of a 3 or higher on at least four or more exams. In 2021, 45 students earned AP Scholar Awards.
- ▶ In 2022, 97 students earned AP Scholar Recognition by earning a 3 or higher on three or more exams. In 2021, 99 students earned AP Scholar Recognition.

Class of 2022 Graduation Trends

Of the 357 graduates in the Class of 2022:

- 86.2% enrolled in a 4-year institution.
- 7% enrolled in a 2-year institution or trade/technical school.
- 5.4% sought employment or were undecided.
- 1.4% went into military service. Three graduates enlisted in the Navy, one in the Army, and one in the Air Force.
- 87% of students were accepted into their first-choice school.

Class of 2022 Graduation Trends

- 12 of our students attended schools ranked in the top 25.
 - In 2022, 253 applications were sent and 15 students were accepted.
 - In 2021, 218 applications were sent and 6 students were accepted.
- 27 of our students attended schools ranked in the top 50.
 - In 2022, 519 applications were sent and 82 students were accepted.
 - In 2021, 471 applications were sent and 81 students were accepted.
- 64 of our students attended schools ranked in the top 75.
 - In 2022, 846 applications were sent and 196 students were accepted.
 - In 2021, 865 applications were sent and 302 students were accepted.

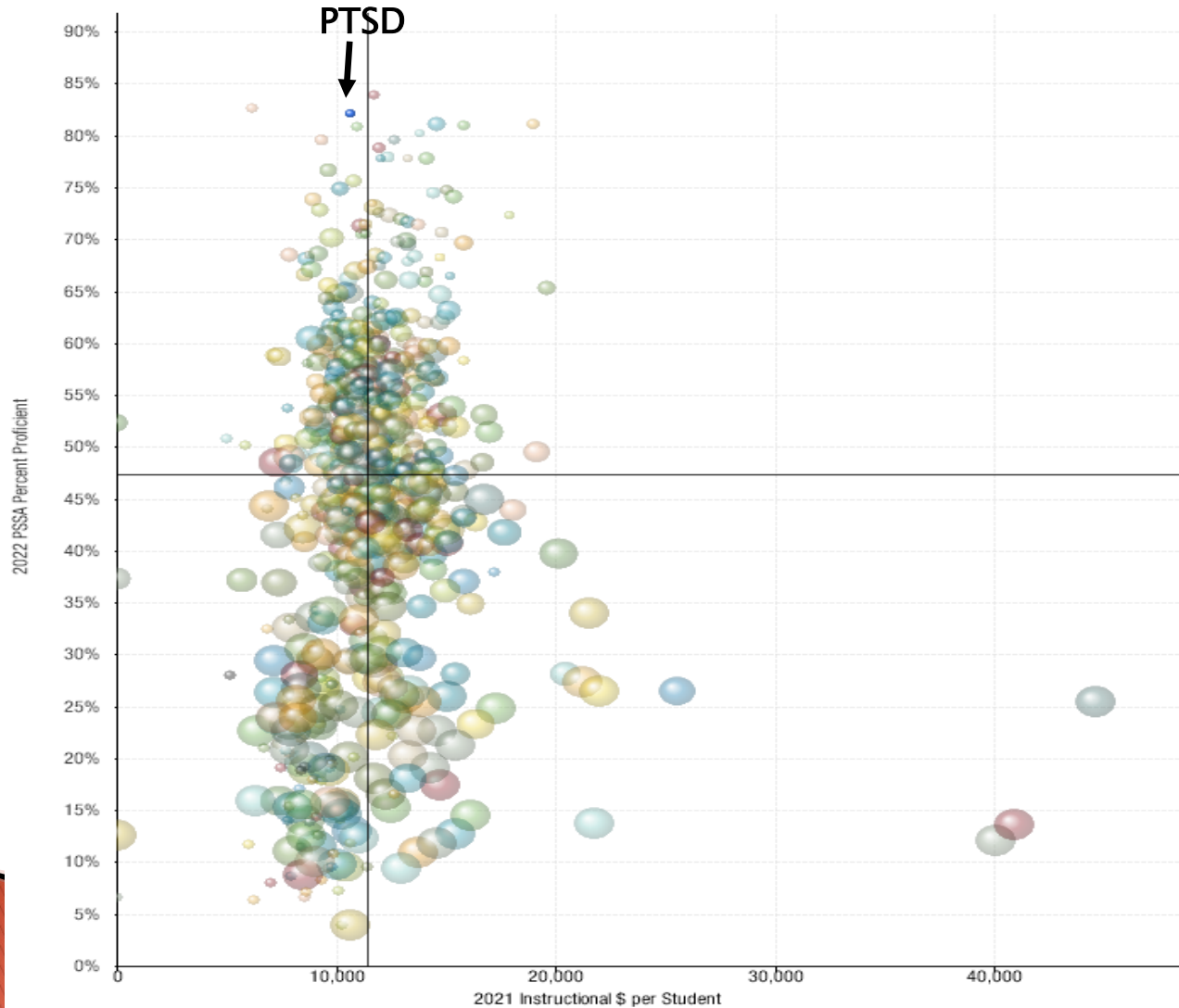
