What is the ESSER Fund (ARP–ESSER) 7% Set Asides?

- ▶ Districts must use their ESSER Fund 7% Set Asides as follows:
 - At least 30% must be targeted to social, emotional, or mental health supports to students.
 - At least 10% must be targeted to professional development and technical assistance to educators and school staff to address the social, emotional, and mental health needs of students.
 - At least 8% must be targeted to reading support and improvement for students.

How is Peters Township District using the ESSER Fund 7% Set Asides?

▶ ARP ESSER Learning Loss Set Aside

- \$12,531.00 has been allocated to provide additional training to teachers and staff to identify, understand and respond to mental health and substance use challenges. In addition to KidTalk, CORE Team, and Student Assistance Program, this training will assist in identifying students in need of additional supports.
- \$4,200.00 has been allocated for additional counselor training to help students dealing with anxiety, stress and depression by teaching them how to develop the skills needed to stop negative thoughts and start thinking and behaving in more positive ways.
- \$25,040.00 will be allocated for Orton Gillingham Training and Certification for select teachers to address reading learning loss. This training will focus on the science of reading.

How will the allocation be used in the Peters Township School District?

- ▶ ARP ESSER Summer School Set Aside.
 - \$8,354.00 has been allocated to offset the cost of reading and math support in the summer for identified students.
- ▶ ARP ESSER After School Set Aside
 - \$8,354.00 has been allocated to offset the cost of high school students in need of credit recovery.
