Dear Parent(s)/Legal Guardian(s):

Your child attends McMurray Elementary School, which receives Federal Title I funds to assist students in meeting state achievement standards. Throughout the school year, we will be providing you with important information about this law and your child's education. This letter lets you know about your right to request information about the qualifications of the classroom staff working with your child.

At McMurray Elementary School, we are very proud of our teachers and feel they are prepared to give your child a high-quality education. As a Title I school, we must meet federal regulations related to teacher qualifications as defined in ESEA. These regulations allow you to learn more about your child's teachers' training and credentials. We are happy to provide this information to you. At any time, you may ask:

- Whether the teacher met state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subject he/she is teaching,
- Whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certificate through which state qualifications were waived, and
- What undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration.

You may also ask whether your child receives help from a paraprofessional. If your child receives this assistance, we can provide you with information about the paraprofessional's qualifications.

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) which was signed into law in December 2015 and reauthorizes the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1956 (ESEA) includes additionally right to know requests. At any time, parents and family members can request:

- Information on policies regarding student participation in assessments and procedures for opting out, and
- Information on required assessments that include:
 - Subject matter tested,
 - Purpose of the test,
 - Source of the requirement (if applicable),
 - Amount of time it takes students to complete the test, and
 - Time and format of disseminating results.

Parent Right to Know Information as Required by The Elementary and Secondary Education Assistance (ESEA) [Section 1112(e)(1)(A)] and the Every Student Succeeds Act [Section 1112(e)(1)(A)]

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Our staff is committed to helping your child develop the academic knowledge and critical thinking he/she needs to succeed in school and beyond. That commitment includes making sure that all of our teachers and paraprofessionals meet applicable Pennsylvania state requirements.

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El Derecho saber de los padres Las Regulaciones 200.61

Estimado padre:

La escuela de su niño recibe financiamiento del Título I y está incluido en las regulaciones del “No Child Left Behind Act/ No Niño Abandonado” (NCLB) que estaba sancionado por Presidente Bush el 8 de enero de 2002.

NCLB requiere:

- Responsabilidades aumentadas para los estados y los distritos de escuela.
- Más escogidos para los padres, especialmente los en las escuelas de bajo desempeño.
- Más flexibilidad para las agencias del estado y local en el uso de financiamiento federal.

Bajo de NCLB, padres tienen el derecho pedir cualificaciones profesionales del (los) profesor(es) o el (los) paraprofesional(es) de sus niños. Esta carta es informarse de su derecho pedir lo siguiente información de los profesores or los paraprofesionales:

- Si Pennsylvania ha autorizado al maestro para los niveles y los temas en lo que él o ella enseña.
- Si el maestro recibió un certificado de emergencia o condicional a través de cual fueron renunciados la calificación de estado.
- La especialidad de bachillerato y si el profesor tiene licenciaturas avanzadas.
- Si el niño recibe servicios por paraprofesionales y, si es así, sus cualificaciones.

Si usted quiere recibir información específica sobre el maestro o el paraprofesional de su niño, por favor contacte con su director de la escuela.
