Dear Students,

As Prom 2024 approaches, there are several procedures that you need to be aware of and that are utilized to ensure a safe and enjoyable season for all students. This year's Junior/Senior Prom will be held on Friday, May 24, 2024, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., at the Omni William Penn in Pittsburgh. Check-in will begin at 6:30 p.m. The cost of a single ticket is \$115.00 or \$230.00 per couple. Tickets will be sold during all three lunch periods from Monday, April 29, 2024, through Friday, May 3, 2024. **Make checks out to PTHS. NO tickets will be sold after this date. NO refunds after Thursday, May 16, 2024.**

Each attendee must complete all necessary paperwork to submit at the time the attendee's ticket is purchased. Outside guests are required to complete a separate form for non-PTHS attendees. Outside guest packets will also be due when tickets are purchased. **NO PTHS or outside guest packets will be accepted after the ticket purchase date.**

Students attending Prom who would like to leave early on Friday, May 24, 2024, must complete a Prom Early Dismissal Form. All Prom participants must attend school on Friday, May 24, 2024 until at least 11:20 a.m. If a student does not attend school or leaves for ANY REASON before 11:20 a.m., the student will not be permitted to participate in the evening's festivities. For early dismissals, please complete and return the early dismissal form by Friday, May 17, 2024. An early dismissal will not be granted unless you have completed the appropriate form and turned it in on time. No exceptions will be made.

To ensure your safety at Prom, the City of Pittsburgh Police will be present. Please note that all legal and school codes must be followed at Prom, and please be aware of the consequences for violating any of the terms outlined on the student agreement page. Remember all Student/Parent Handbook rules and Peters Township School District policies are in effect for the evening.
