
Points, Lines, and Planes

Here are some important geometric terms.






Point

A point is an exact location in space. This is point X.


Line

A line is a straight path of points that goes on and on in both directions. This is line AB.




Parallel lines

Perpendicular lines


Perpendicular lines form right angles.


