Dear Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2024,

Congratulations to you and your high school senior! As we gear up for our 2024 Senior Week Activities and Commencement Ceremony, we're eager to provide you with essential details for this momentous occasion. Attached, you'll find 2024 Graduation Information outlining important events and dates for easy reference.

Commencement will be held at Confluence Financial Partners Stadium (located at the Middle School) on *Friday, June 7th at 7:00 p.m.* for all graduates. There will be no attendance limits, and tickets will not be required at the stadium. Seating will be available on both sides of the field. In the event of inclement weather on Friday evening, the ceremony will be relocated indoors to the AHN Arena (High School Gymnasium). Should the event move indoors, tickets will be necessary for entry. Each family will receive six tickets for the event. Any changes in location will be communicated via the automated calling system. Students will receive their cap, gown, and commencement tickets during their lunch period on *Thursday, April* **25th.** It is important to follow the care instructions provided for the cap and gown, and to keep the commencement tickets in a secure location. Please note that decorating the cap is not permitted, and students must adhere to the dress code for the ceremony. Students attending the Western Area Career and Technology Center (WACTC) will participate in their Certificate Ceremonies wearing their Peters Township cap and gown.

The last day of regular classes for seniors is *Monday, June 3rd*, with final grades computed on *Tuesday, June 4th*. However, graduation honors status will be determined based on student grades as of *Thursday, May 16th*. It's the students' responsibility to ensure that all coursework is up to date in all classes. Additionally, students must indicate their "attending school" status in Naviance to facilitate the sending of their Final Transcript.

We're thrilled to celebrate our seniors' last week at PTHS with enjoyable and memorable activities, including a Senior Assembly and Picnic at Rolling Hills Park after indoor practice on *Tuesday, June 4th*; a Field Trip on *Wednesday, June 5th*; and a PTSA-sponsored breakfast and Elementary Walk followed by outdoor practice on *Thursday, June 6th*. Friday, June 7th, 2024, is reserved as a make-up day if needed. We're excited for the Class of 2024 to partake in the tradition of walking the halls of the elementary schools in their graduation attire. This experience allows our seniors to witness their journey come full circle as they're cheered on by elementary students and teachers. Graduates will receive a more detailed schedule for senior week practices and activities in May.

Lastly, please ensure that your child clears any debts or obligations, including library books, textbooks, school equipment, lunch balances, athletic uniforms, and/or equipment, or any other debts/fines by *May 31st*, enabling them to fully participate in all senior activities and commencement exercises. District-issued laptops and accessories will be collected on *June 4th* during Commencement Practice.

We're excited to celebrate this significant milestone with the Class of 2024 and eagerly anticipate all the graduation festivities on June 7th.
