Dear Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2025,

Congratulations to you and your high school senior! As we gear up for our 2025 Senior Week Activities and Commencement Ceremony, we're eager to provide you with essential details for this momentous occasion. Attached, you'll find 2025 Graduation Information outlining important events and dates for easy reference.

Commencement will be held at Confluence Financial Partners Stadium (located at the Middle School) on *Friday, June 6th at 7:00 p.m.* for all graduates. There will be no attendance limits, and tickets will not be required at the stadium. Seating will be available on both sides of the field. In the event of inclement weather on Friday evening, the ceremony will be relocated indoors to the AHN Arena (High School Gymnasium). Should the event move indoors, tickets will be necessary for entry. Each family will receive five tickets for the event. Any changes in location will be communicated via the automated calling system. Students will receive their cap, gown, and commencement tickets during their lunch period on *Thursday, April* **24th.** It is important to follow the care instructions provided for the cap and gown and to keep the commencement tickets in a secure location. Please note that decorating the cap is not permitted, and students must adhere to the dress code for the ceremony. Students attending the Western Area Career and Technology Center (WACTC) will participate in their Certificate Ceremony on Thursday, May 15th wearing their Peters Township cap and gown.

The last day of regular classes for seniors is *Friday, May 30th*, with final grades computed on *Monday, June 2nd*. However, graduation honors status will be determined based on student grades as of *Friday, May 16th*. It's the students' responsibility to ensure that all coursework is up-to-date in all classes. Additionally, students must indicate their "attending school" status in Naviance to facilitate the sending of their final transcript.

We're excited to celebrate our seniors' final week at PTHS with fun activities in addition to graduation practice. These include trips to Kennywood and Washington Wild Things, a PTSA-sponsored breakfast, Senior Assembly, and Video Yearbook. The Class of 2025 will also enjoy the tradition of walking through the elementary schools in their graduation attire, cheered on by younger students and staff. A detailed schedule for senior week will be provided in May.

Lastly, please ensure that your child clears any debts or obligations, including library books, textbooks, school equipment, lunch balances, athletic uniforms and/or equipment, or any other debts/fines by *May 30th*, enabling them to fully participate in all senior activities and commencement exercises. District-issued laptops and accessories will be collected during all three lunch periods on *May 30th*.
