## **Appearance and Conduct for Commencement**

Commencement is a formal ceremony; all participating seniors agree to follow all dress, appearance, behavioral and procedural rules, and regulations. Student conduct during the commencement ceremony will be respectful and dignified. Each senior deserves to celebrate this accomplishment without disruption. Any behavior that causes or threatens to disrupt the ceremony may lead to removal.

**Required Attire:** All students must wear business or dress attire under their graduation gown. This includes white dress shirt, dress pants or a dress and dress shoes. Sneakers, flip-flops, or similar shoes are not appropriate for the ceremony. Please note that spiked heels will sink into the turf field and should be avoided.

## Field Access & Photography

Parents & guests *ARE NOT* permitted on the field during the ceremony, including to take pictures. Immediately following commencement, families are welcome onto the field for photographs. A professional photographer has been contracted to take photographs during the ceremony that will be made available to families for purchase following the event.
