Dear Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2022:

Congratulations to you and your high school senior. We are preparing for our 2022 Commencement Ceremony and this letter provides information for Seniors for the last few weeks of their high school career. A separate sheet outlining important events and dates is also attached.

The **Junior/Senior Prom** is **Friday, May 20** at Heinz Field in Pittsburgh from 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. The Junior Class officers and sponsors have been working tirelessly to plan an event that will be memorable for our students. Any student attending PTHS Prom must be in school until 11:20 a.m. All students must use the Early Release Prom Form that was included in the prom packet if they are requesting an early dismissal on May 20.

Commencement will take place at Confluence Financial Partners Stadium (Middle School) on **Friday, June 3 at 7:00 p.m.** for all graduates. Attendance will not be limited, and tickets will not be required at the stadium. Seating will be open on both sides of the field. In the event of inclement weather on Friday evening, the event will be moved inside to the AHN Arena (High School Gymnasium). If the event is moved indoors, tickets will be required for admittance. Each family will receive five tickets for the event. Families will be notified via the automated calling system of any changes in location. For the purpose of determining graduation honors, senior grades will be pulled on **Friday, May 13, 2022**. Students are responsible for ensuring that all their work is current by that date in all classes. Final exams for seniors will begin on May 23 (please see the attached schedule). Transcripts will be available with final grades after **June 15, 2022**. The counseling office will provide students with information regarding the submission of final transcripts to colleges and universities.

Students will receive their caps and gowns and graduation tickets on **Thursday, April 28** during their lunch period. Please note the care instructions and keep commencement tickets in a safe place. Students attending *Western Area Career and Technology Center* will participate in their graduation ceremonies (See [WACTC Graduation Schedules](#) for specific dates and times).

Graduation practice and senior activities will take place on the following dates: *Tuesday, May 31; Wednesday, June 1; Thursday, June 2, 2022*. Please ensure that your child clears any debts or obligations including library books, textbooks, school equipment, athletic uniforms and/or equipment or debts/fines by **May 27** so that they can fully participate in all senior activities and commencement exercises.

We are excited to celebrate this important milestone with the Class of 2022 and look forward to all of the graduation festivities on June 3.
