Then it was time for the fair. There were many pumpkins in the contest. The mayor is always the judge. Slowly, he walked around the pumpkins.

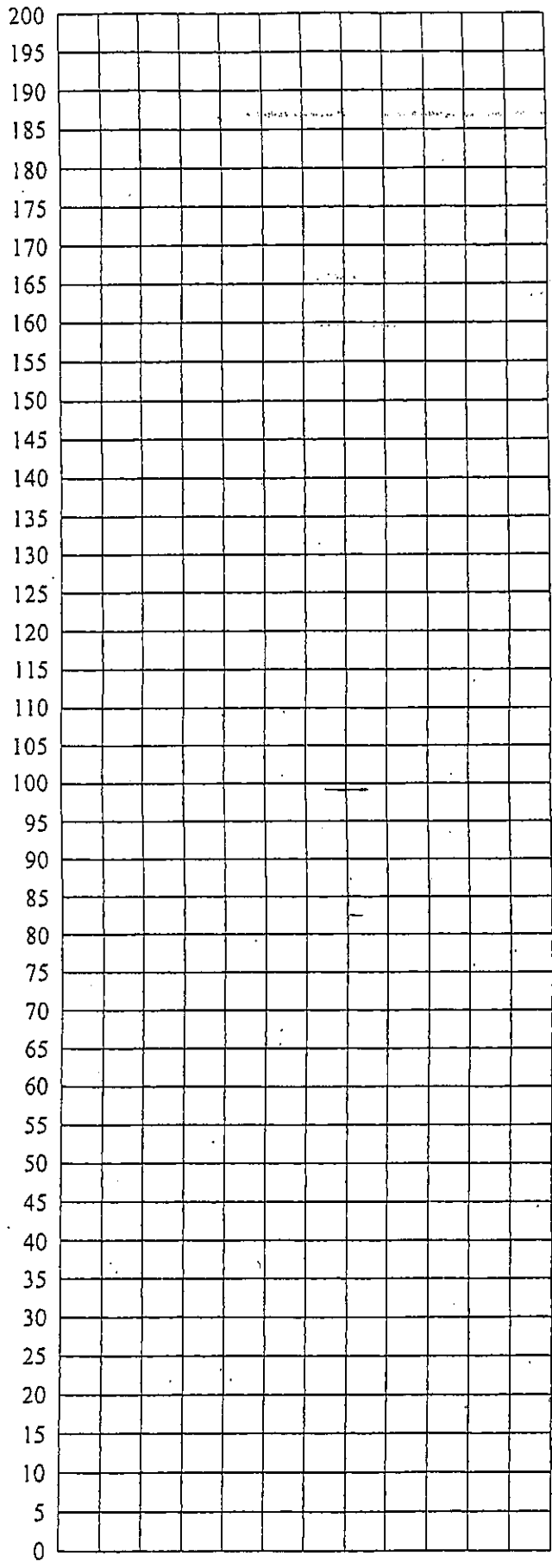
The mayor stopped at Ricky's pumpkin. "This is the biggest pumpkin in the village. Ricky wins the crown!" he said. Everyone cheered.
