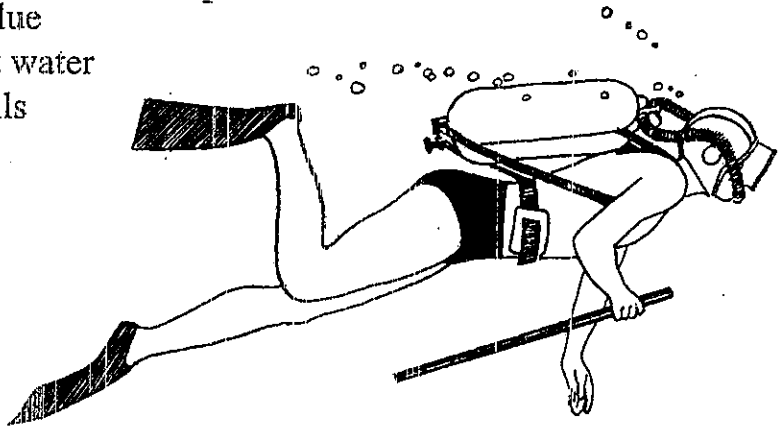

 48 dive and swim under water.

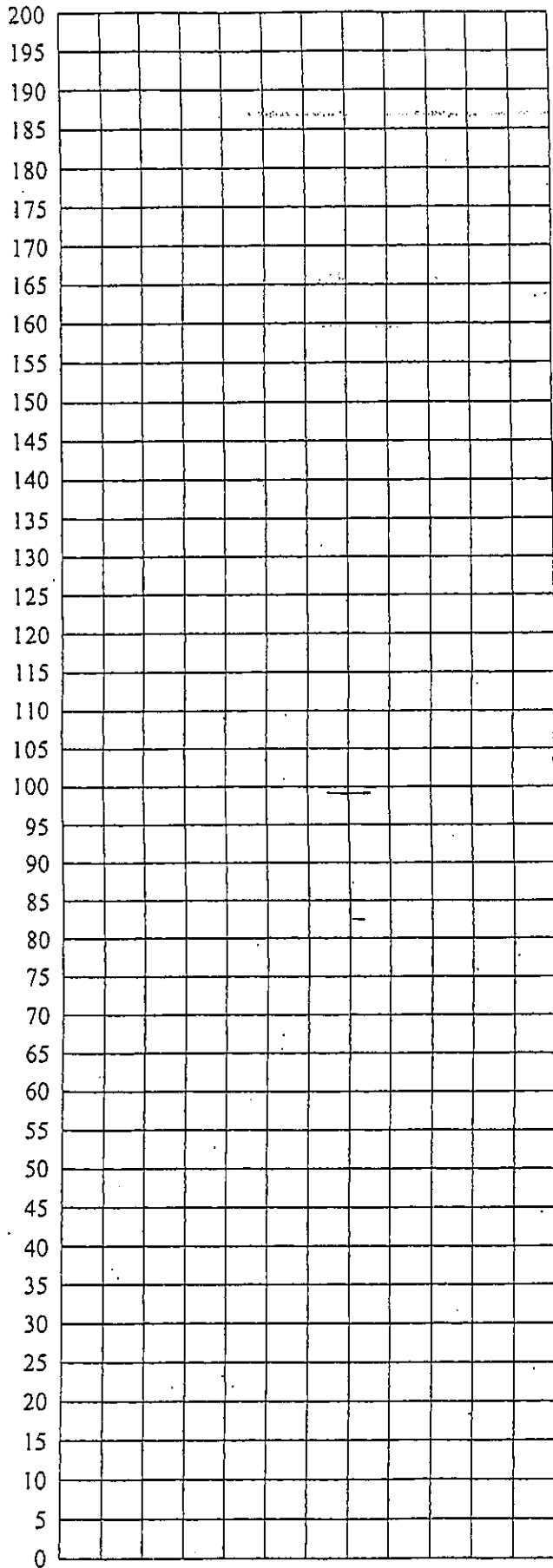
54 Scuba divers use scuba gear. The
