





#1 Lockers

- Your child will be assigned a locker
 - All lockers have a combination lock
- Lockers can be accessed between classes
 - It is your child's responsibility to keep his/her locker organized and clean

We suggest ...

- Buy a combination lock and have them practice over the summer
- Remind them that...
 - The first week of school will be the most challenging - it will get easier!
 - The Guidance Office has all the combinations written down (if they forget!)

#2 Getting Lost & Being Late

- The First Day Schedule is Adjusted
 - Allows additional time for students to get organized
 - Teachers will be in the halls to help students find their way
- Students typically adjust quickly to changing classes
 - Time management is key!
 - As long as they are direct and efficient, they will not struggle to get to classes on time.
- If late, have a pass from a staff member

We suggest ...

- # Having your student attend the 6th Grade Orientation held in August to walk their schedule and practice their locker combo
- Remind them that staff members will be there to help

#3 Homework



- Will your child have homework? YES!
 - It is typical to have homework almost every night (especially in math)
- Don't let it pile up!
- Online Homework Canvas Parent App Teachers post a "Week at a Glance" in Canvas that explains the assignments for the week.
- Grades reported in PowerSchool

Other Information

Absences

- It is your student's responsibility to speak with each teacher and ask about make-up work.
- If your child is out for 3 or more days...
 - Notify the Main Office, nurse and/or your child's counselor
 - Check the Week-at-a-glance for assignments
 - Students can access some assignments on Canvas
- The Make-Up Work Policy can be found in the student handbook (under the "Parent Quick Links" tab on the website).

Dress Code

Music Course requests

Parents/Guardians must complete a Google Form indicating which 12-week music class their child would like to take for 6^{th} grade. All students take one 12-week music class.



- 1. Comprehensive Music General music class, most like what students had at McMurray.
- 2. Band Instrumental Music This class is for students who play a band instrument. Students selecting this option will also take the Band performance music class.
- 3. Strings Instrumental This class is for students who play an orchestra instrument. Students selecting this option will also take the Orchestra performance music class.
- 4. Chorus For students who love to sing. There will be an evening performance at the end of the trimester as part of this class. Students who take Chorus also have the option of taking the Choral Ensemble performance music class.






